

Cincinnati Children's Inpatient Daily Census Report

Effective 1/8/24, the determination of system level Red/Yellow/Green for capacity has been updated as well as for all inpatient sites of care. The previous capacity assessment was not aligned with organizational growth and budgeted capacity resulting in an overestimate of system stress and a high frequency of red status at the system and unit levels. The updated system assesses capacity in terms of Acute Care (including Base, Liberty and Hem/Onc/BMT), Critical Care and Mental Health (excluding residential care) with defined thresholds that will identify red status requiring Site of Care and System level mitigation, yellow status that has a focus on unit mitigation and green status (normal operations).

- Color coding on box outlines: Red = High, Yellow = Moderate, Green = Low
- LWBS % represents the percentage of patients that left the ER without being seen
- Avg. arrival to MD represents the length of time from patient arrival to being seen by physician
- Avg. LOS Admits represents the length of time from patient arrival to admission
- Avg. LOS DC represents the length of time from patient arrival to discharge
- Acute census represents all general inpatients which excludes patients in NICU, PICU, CICU, CBDI and Psychiatry beds
